- YOUR FLOAT NUMBER CORRESPONDS TO YOUR PLACE IN THE PARADE. PLEASE PLACE THIS SHEET IN YOUR FRONT WINDOW TO ASSIST US IN MAKING SURE WE HAVE THE PROPER ENTRY ORDER.
- THE PARADE WILL START IN DEWOLFE PARK AT 5:45 P.M. AND WILL TRAVEL NORTH ON THE BEDFORD HIGHWAY FINISHING AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE BEDFORD PLACE MALL BY DOOLY'S AND TRUE NORTH DINER
- YOU ARE NOT TO IMBIBE ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BEFORE OR DURING THE PARADE!
- ▶ PLEASE TRY TO KEEP UP WITH THE UNITS IN FRONT OF YOU (AT A SAFE DISTANCE OF COURSE) DO NOT LET A LARGE AMOUNT OF SPACE ACCUMULATE BETWEEN YOU AND THE UNIT IN FRONT OF YOU. YOUR SPEED SHOULD BE ROUGHLY 8-10 Kms/hour.

SPOTTER INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Please remain beside or on the float at all times during the parade.
- 2. Please do not allow viewers to walk up to the float during the parade. It is imperative that no one try to run up to the float. They could slip easily and fall under the wheels.
- 3. Once the parade begins, all persons on the float must remain on the float until the parade ends, the float has stopped and it is safe to disembark.
- 4. Please do not allow the children and adults on the float to throw objects, advertising materials, candy etc. from the float during the parade.
